## Social Equity Award

The Social Equity Award will be given to a public policy, affairs, or administration program that exemplifies the highest standards in social equity through outstanding contributions in:

- **Research:** Demonstrated faculty scholarship of discovery, integration, or application of social equity
- **Teaching:** Demonstrated faculty record of outstanding teaching and/or the development of curriculum focused on social equity
- **Service:** Demonstrated faculty and staff records of service and contribution to the public or nonprofit sector focused on activities that promote or support social equity

## Diversity Award

The Diversity Award will be given to a public policy, affairs, or administration program that exemplifies the highest standards in diversity through outstanding contributions in:

- **Research:** Demonstrated faculty scholarship of discovery, integration, or application of diversity
- **Teaching:** Demonstrated faculty record of outstanding teaching and/or the development of curriculum focused on diversity
- **Service:** Demonstrated faculty and staff records of service and contribution to the public or nonprofit sector focused on activities that promote or support diversity

## Social Justice Curriculum Award

Co-sponsored by NYU Wagner and UCLA Luskin, this award promotes incorporating a social justice lens into the core curriculum of NASPAA schools. This \$1,000 award will be given to a faculty member or faculty team that has developed a required core course that meets this objective. Social justice is broadly defined.

## Application process: self-nominations are encouraged

To apply, applicants should submit the following information to [awards@nasaap.org](mailto:awards@nasaap.org):

- Nomination email with a 500 word or fewer summary of why the program should be selected
- Identify 2 people who will supply supporting summaries of the applicant; when possible, submit the supporting summaries with the nomination email
- Social Justice Curriculum Award applicants should include a copy of the course syllabi and relevant supporting material
- Submissions should include the award name and the candidate name in the email subject line
